

our story

Butler's historic Penn Theater is the last of its great 20th century moviehouses. Situated near the corner of North & Main, The Penn is an anchor for Butler's Historical & Cultural Districts. The Penn Theater opened on April 22, 1938, & has witnessed various highs & lows, re-openings & closings, & renovations, throughout its storied history. Styled with classic 1930s art deco appeal, geometric shapes, neon, brass, marble, & deep reds, ambers, whites, blacks, grays, & indigos, the facility features five distinct event spaces: the Lydia Mainstage, a now multipurpose & reconfigurable large venue, the Bantam Auditorium, a smaller box theater with fixed seating, & three club or conference rooms, each accommodating guests for events either in the Lydia or Bantam or reservations themselves.

our mission

 To reinvigorate the historic Penn Theater as the region's premiere hub for arts, entertainment, culture, & heritage through community-centered, high-quality, diverse events, promoting economic revitalization for downtown Butler, while enriching the quality of life for our citizens & lifting up the needs of those marginalized across our community.

- To envision a theater that is more than a building, but a gateway to downtown Butler, an anchor for its rich cultural & historic heritage, a source for outreach & support, & the region's heart for arts, events, & culture.
- To envision a multiuse, community-centered facility, where all feel welcomed, where all feel a sense of what Ray Oldenburg in 1989 called the 'third place,' or one's home away from home – neither home nor work, but that place where they feel a sense of belonging, & where they long to return.
- To envision collaborations with key public & private stakeholders to help the community experience the magic of Butler again.

The old girl is being restored to her former glory while also getting major upgrades, like the sound & lighting equipment, staging, projection, service areas, hospitality areas, concession & ticketing areas, & restroom facilities in the Lydia & the Bantam, plus the old balcony & projection room have been converted into corporate boxes! No - the art deco isn't going anywhere, & we're rehabilitating the Lydia's murals & the iconic P-E-N-N neon marquee!

how is this a non-profit?

The Penn Theater is operated by the Penn Theater Performance Company, a tax-exempt, non-profit, 501(c)(3) corporation, which has a charitable, community-serving purpose for all of Butler! The physical building is owned by Wallace Group Productions, run by Bryan & Marina Frenchak, two philanthropists & community organizers. Bryan is Butler-born & Butler-proud!
